OPENING DOORS TO OPPORTUNITY

Veterans face several challenges in transitioning to civilian life and Joe Giordano with Project Opportunity decided that their dreams of business ownership shouldn't be one of them. After a 20-year career in the military, Joe founded Project Opportunity in 2010 as an alternative to traditional employment and in response to the high unemployment rate among the veteran population. Project Opportunity provides free entrepreneur training for veterans, active duty, reservist and military spouses who wished to start or expand a small business.

In 2020, the program expanded to offer entrepreneur training courses, free business counseling and coaching, professional development workshops and seminars, and an annual business pitch competition, awarding \$20,000 to the winning Project Opportunity graduate. The 10-week program helps aspiring entrepreneurs conduct market research, develop a business plan, connect with local resources, and culminates with a formal graduation.





Project Opportunity offers courses on a rotating basis for veterans and veteran spouses. This Spring, veteran spouses can register for the 10-week program, beginning with an orientation session on March 15th. Ideal participants are thinking about starting a business or are in the beginning stages of launching a business and are ready to learn! Participants can register here.
