Every child deserves to be included and celebrated. This is something that Shari Bailey, founder of Zigglebee and Laila's Gift, knows firsthand. Shari is a mom to twin girls, Laila and Lana. When she was pregnant with her daughters, she learned that Laila had a heart defect and was going to need surgery at birth. After birth and 4 long months in the hospital, Laila was diagnosed with Jacobson Syndrome, a rare congenital condition, of which, at the time, Laila was one of only 100 known cases. Raising twins is no small task, and raising a child with special needs is even more challenging. Shari understands the difficulties of raising a child with differing abilities, and wanted to help other families in a similar situation.

In April 2022, Shari founded Laila's Gift, a nonprofit in honor of her daughter, that aims to celebrate the birthdays of children with special needs and differing abilities. Powered through the generosity of "Gifters", Laila's Gift aims to raise \$100,000 dollars to celebrate children's birthdays in 2023. Each party is customized to the needs and passions of each child and includes gifts, decorations, and party friends! Shari shares that she, "wants to take the burden off of families and make kids feel not only included, but celebrated in their community". Shari isn't the only entrepreneur in the family! Laila's twin sister Lana is also taking the leap into entrepreneurship. Lana and Laila share a special bond as twins, but that bond looks different with Laila's disabilities. Laila is non-verbal, so communicating with each other is challenging. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Shari encouraged Lana to do something creative instead of watching TV all day. So, Lana pulled out some paper and began writing a story. She stepped away for a few minutes and came back to find Laila drawing pictures on her story. Both Lana and Shari were thrilled to see Laila communicating in this way and this new bond inspired Lana to create Zigglebee, a book of stories with no pictures.

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Zigglebee is designed for children to put themselves into the story by drawing their own pictures based on the story's outline. Regardless of ability, race, or experience, each child can use their imagination and create a story based on their reality. Since its official launch in July, 2022, Zigglebee has not only helped children express their creativity, but has also helped them with word recognition, speech therapy, and so much more. Creating two businesses in one year is no small tasks, but Shari, Lana, and Laila aren't slowing down! Shari hopes that in the next few years, Laila's Gift can continue to grow and provide additional services and resources to families with special needs children.
