

What is one of the most effective ways to emotionally connect with your consumer? According to a Forbes.com article, "[consumers] are fed so many pieces of content that graphics or images no longer appeal to [them]. [Their] minds crave stimulation [and] video can create an instant rush of emotions". Video marketing is a powerful tool that has only increased in demand over the last several years. Tony Kosack and Jacob Huey, owners of KO-OP Media understand the importance of how video can create a connection that sets a company or brand a part from its competition.

KO-OP Media is a commercial video production company that seeks to solve creative problems by providing visual marketing pieces to elevate brands- taking clients from start to finish. The story of its origins and how the business was born are typical of many entrepreneurs who hit a point in life where they chose to take risks to pursue their true passions.

Tony was originally a professional hair stylist, utilizing video to showcase his talents at a time when the popular app Instagram expanded features to include video sharing. He took inspiration from famous YouTuber, Casey Neistat, and began to teach himself video filming and editing. Not long after, he quit his stylist job and jumped right in. Tony leverages his natural creativity to craft emotional pieces, using narratives to tell a business' story in a manner that gets consumers connected to its products or services.

Jacob was studying kinesiology, and had always supported his childhood friend in his career pursuits.



He had even dabbled in video editing on the side himself and managed to snag some side work when he realized he had to rethink his career goals. With the encouragement of a professor, Jacob joined the company in 2019.

In the beginning it was challenging balancing friendship with business, establishing a defined company structure, and identifying strategies to gain profitability. Tony and Jacob quickly learned that "making money and keeping money [were] two different things" and encourage new business owners to have the right people in their corner. Jacob adds, "Your CPA will be your business best friend: mentors are critical for success; and be active in your community."

Today, KO-OP is proud of its everexapnding networks with other creatives throughout Maryland and beyond, as well as clients including some local favorites: the Crabby Axe Throwing, the Harford County Chamber, Island Spice Grille & Lounge, and the soon to debut Konoko Jamaican restaurant in White Marsh among many others.

Their repeat and referral business is reflective of the quality of their work, and the pride they take in producing visual pieces that highlight the communities in which they live.




